

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

If Stopped by Police or Immigration

1. REMAIN SILENT

You have the right to remain silent. You do not have to answer questions about your status.

Say: "I am exercising my right to remain silent."

2. DO NOT CONSENT TO SEARCH

You have the right to refuse a search of your person, car, or home without a warrant.

Say: "I do not consent to a search."

3. ASK TO LEAVE

If you are not under arrest, you may be free to go.

Say: "Am I free to go?"

4. ASK FOR A LAWYER
